TRUST MOTION PASSES AT FOOTBALL SUPPORTERS' ASSOCIATION AGM

The FSA is the national, democratic, representative body for football supporters in England and Wales. As an affiliate member, the Trust was able to submit a motion to the FSA to be discussed at their Annual General Meeting on Saturday 16th July. As a board we agreed to submit the below motion in the hope of raising the issue of Youth Participation/Representation In Supporters Groups & Community-Owned Football Clubs:

"To commit to exploring the optimum path to develop and sustain greater participation and representation of young people in the Football Supporters' Association. To explore the best method to support its member supporters organisations and community-owned football clubs in also developing and sustaining greater participation and representation of young people within their structures."

With the Fulham Supporters' Trust seconding the motion at the AGM, it passed unanimously. This highlights our commitment to contributing at the national level, and our work to help other community owned clubs and supporters groups across the country.

Thank you to Luke Cox, our recently co-opted board member, for taking a lead on this.
